WARREN SPOUSES' CLUB 2020 SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

I. GENERAL INFORMATION

The Warren Spouses' Club Scholarship provides for the possible awarding of several scholarships to qualified and selected applicants. Scholarship applications must be mailed and postmarked no later than March 20, 2020. Scholarship recipients will be notified of their selection by April 17, 2020. Scholarship Awards must be formally accepted by April 24, 2020 or they will be awarded to an alternate scholarship winner. It is the policy of the WSC that these awards be used to defray basic education expenses such as tuition, books, lab fees and room/board.

II. ELIGIBILITY

An applicant must be a dependent of a military sponsor. The military sponsor of said applicant must be of active duty, guard, reserve, retired or deceased status from a United States branch of service AND either assigned to F.E. Warren AFB in active duty status or a resident in Laramie County or the outlying areas serviced by F.E. Warren personnel. The applicant must be a student and/or have been accepted to a regionally-accredited vocational/technical school, college, university or graduate school not currently under investigation by or facing sanctions from the Department of Education, including but not limited to schools unable to accept federal financial aid. Regional accreditation requirement may be waived for vocational/technical schools regional accreditation if not offered for applicant's field of study.

III. INELIGIBILITY

Executive Board members are not eligible the year they are on the board and the year after, but their children are eligible.

IV. DISQUALIFICATION

Any applicant who fails to supply a complete application on or before March 20, 2020

deadline will be automatically disqualified. The applicant will receive notification of disqualification in writing no later than April 3, 2020.

V. SELECTION CRITERIA

Recipients of the scholarship awards will be selected by an independent panel based upon demonstrated scholastic achievement as indicated on transcripts, college entrance exam scores (i.e. ACT/SAT, GRE/MCAT/LSAT/GMAT, etc., when applicable), participation in school and community activities, and a personal essay. The panel shall consist of a minimum of three persons who are not, and may not be, members of the Warren Spouses' Club (WSC). The WSC Scholarship Committee will select the panel members, and notify the WSC Board upon selection.

VI. DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS

The scholarship funds will be distributed in one payment at the beginning of the summer or fall semester upon receipt of a copy of the school's financial statement showing registration, tuition, lab fees etc., to verify enrollment in an accredited institution. The student must provide the WSC Scholarship Chair with this verification by September 30, 2020. Failure to follow these guidelines will result in remittance of award to an alternate scholarship winner.

The check will be made payable to the accredited institution.

VII. OTHER

Acceptance of a military academy appointment, full ROTC Scholarship, or any full scholarship either before or after selection as a WSC Scholarship recipient, will terminate the applicant's consideration for entitlement to this scholarship. In such an event, the scholarship will be awarded to an alternate.

Please study the rubric carefully and include as many of the critical elements as possible in your essay. Points will be given for each critical element present in the essay. Do your best on all of them.
Rubric: The Rubric contains 7 Critical Elements. Presence of a focused thesis. Adequate support and examples. Shows consideration of purpose and audience. Gains the interest of the reader and has unity. Good topic sentences, transitions and effective conclusion. Proper grammar, punctuation and spelling. Format instructions were followed.
